



## 2020 KIDS FOR CONSERVATION Birdhouse Competition Information & Guidelines

1. The artist must be in grades 9 - 12.
2. Student's name, school and title of project must be written on each birdhouse. Please use permanent marker and write on the bottom of the birdhouse.
3. Birdhouses must have a visible title. Birdhouses without a title will be disqualified.
4. Teachers, please submit one copy of each student's form to the front desk of the library. Have all forms in a folder labeled with your school's name.
5. Teachers must also email an Excel spreadsheet (example included) containing the student's information to [nhenderson@sewe.com](mailto:nhenderson@sewe.com).
6. All birdhouses must be built primarily from natural material and/or recyclable goods.
7. The birdhouses will be judged on the following criteria:
  - a. Creativity
  - b. Craftsmanship
  - c. Type of material used for building
8. All entries should be portable (by one person) and able to stand alone on a display table.
9. Birdhouses should be dropped off at the Charleston County Public Library, Main Branch (68 Calhoun Street, Charleston, SC) between **Friday, January 31<sup>th</sup> and Monday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>**.
10. The winners of the Birdhouse Competition will be announced the week of February 3<sup>rd</sup>.
11. Birdhouses should be picked up **between Monday, February 24<sup>th</sup> and Friday, February 28<sup>th</sup>**. *SEWE nor the Library will be responsible for any lost or damaged artwork.*
